**NOTES**

- Student rate is for those who are on a current course of study with NTC and/or British Isles Nazarene Ministers.
- Alumni students will be charged the same as guests – see guest rates.
- Students are not permitted to allow visitors to stay overnight in their room.

- Students are able to access their room from 3pm on the day of arrival. **They are requested to clear the room by 10am on the day of departure.**

**PAYMENT TERMS**

All invoices for short-term accommodation will be raised and sent out to the student in advance of their arrival and are payable either in advance or on the first day of occupation.

If the duration of your stay takes place over the weekend, or out of office hours, you will be required to pay prior to your arrival, either in person, by phone, through post, or by posting it through the letterbox at the front entrance of the White House on Campus (this letterbox is securely locked on the other side).
